Here are instructions for enabling access to a machine for our ansible server to talk to:

1. Open SSH, install openssh-server
2. Add the public key to `/root/.ssh/authorized_keys`
3. If not created:
 1. `cd /root`
 2. `mkdir .ssh`
 3. `chmod 700 .ssh`
 4. `touch .ssh/authorized_keys`
 5. `chmod 600 .ssh/authorized_keys`
 6. edit `.ssh/authorized_keys` to include:
