Here are instructions for enabling access to a machine for our ansible server to talk to:

1. Open SSH, install openssh-server
2. Add the public key to /root/.ssh/authorized_keys
3. If not created:
 1. cd /root
 2. mkdir .ssh
 3. chmod 700 .ssh
 4. touch .ssh/authorized_keys
 5. chmod 600 .ssh/authorized_keys
 6. edit .ssh/authorized_keys to include:
